


Principal's Message Term 1 Week 9 - 25th March 2020

Firstly, I would like to extend a sincere thank you to all of our families who continue to support our school, teachers, students and families through this very challenging time. Consistent with previous messages, I want to reiterate that our school is remaining open to those who MUST send their children. If you have the capacity to keep your children home it is strongly encouraged to help prevent the spread of the Covid-19 virus.

I want to assure that all of our students' learning will be catered for and they will be provided an education, however things will be a little different. Home learning and school learning will now follow the same sequence and content. As I'm writing this we are currently setting up for our first learning packs to be distributed for pick-up. Please note, that these learning packs are designed to allow education to continue through till the end of Term 1. These packs will be available for pick up between 1:30-2:30pm on Wednesday 25th March and between 10am-11am Thursday 26th March. If you can't be available for these times, contact the office to arrange pick-up by appointment.



Maintaining contact with your teacher and our school will be vital in continuing to assist with your child's learning. For this reason our staff have been training and building their expertise to cater for learning online through Google Classroom. As we move forward this will become your direct link to your child's virtual classroom and their teacher. There will be more information explaining how to access and navigate this platform later in the week. We have been getting lots of questions about device requirements. I want to ensure our community that learning will be catered for to ensure no one misses out. Even with a smart phone you'll be able to access learning plans and provide two-way communication. When this is untenable there will phone calls and emails to maintain contact. With this in mind, we are catering for learning with non-digital packs for all (until the end of Term 1) and we will continue with these where necessary in the future.

As for general communication, please stay updated with our KSPS Facebook page, KSPS Website (Learning from Home tab) and our Sentral app. If you have any questions or queries during school time, please feel free to contact the office. This applies with your child's **attendance** as well. If you haven't already contacted our office to let us know your intentions for learning from home or if your child is sick, please do so at your earliest convenience.

I ask everyone to continue being patient and supportive during these difficult times. Procedures and expectations for our school and community are changing very rapidly and we will continue to follow expert advice and act accordingly.

While many of you are preparing for schooling at home with your children, please maintain your first priority being your family's safety. Use this time to connect and undertake learning in various forms, find the positives and be the calm for your children during this storm.


The health, safety and wellbeing of our communities and our people is our first priority.


Due to the rapidly developing situation with coronavirus, School Banking has been temporarily paused from **20 March 2020** until the start of **Term 2**.


