Stage 1 Intensive Swimming Scheme 2021

Message to Parents / Caregivers,

The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The Program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson being 45 minutes. King Street Public School cares for the safety of all its students and encourages parents to support this program. The Intensive Swimming program is a compulsory component of the NSW Department of Education Curriculum.

The Stage 1 Intensive Swimming Program will run for two weeks from **Monday 23rd August to Friday 3rd September**. The scheme will cater for all Stage 1 students at the Singleton Swim and Gym Pool.

The **total cost** for the **10-day scheme is \$40.00** – This is non-refundable and is paid as a whole package. **This cost has been highly subsidised by the school to be \$4 per lesson including transport.** Payment can be made at the school office or on the school website.

What to bring: a swimming costume, goggles, towel and a warm school jumper for afterwards. Please also pack a plastic bag to send wet swimmers home in.

Cost: \$40 per student.

When: Monday 23rd August – Friday 3rd September.

Notes must be returned by Friday 20th of August so that the school can finalise bookings with the pool and bus company.

INSURANCE: Parents please note there is no personal injury insurance cover provided by the NSW Department of Education and Training for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. Parents and caregivers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, zone, area and state school associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover, above that provided by Medicare, is required.
